ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Chaudhary Bansi Lal University, Bhiwani has been established by the Government of Haryana under Act No. 25 of 2014 as a Multi-disciplinary teaching-cum-affiliating university to facilitate higher education in multiple disciplines with special emphasis on sports and physical education and to achieve excellence in Sports, Health and Science.

As a state university recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) under 2(f) and 12-B, CBLU envisages establishing and perpetuating the tradition of excellence in innovative teaching, research and community outreach with the objective of fulfilling the societal responsibilities—local as well as global. Located in Bhiwani, the University has 61 affiliated colleges spread over two districts—Charkhi Dadri and Bhiwani with approximately 40,000 students enrolled with the University. It offers various career-oriented undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral research programmes under six faculties. The University has already adopted the NEP-2020 in spirit by implementing CBCS scheme of examination in all the UG and PG programmes that have been updated with the latest teaching-learning strategies conducive to the aspiring students' holistic development.

Despite the constraints of space and other resources, the University has well-equipped laboratories and full-time internet connectivity. Still in its infancy, the University is striving towards stupendous excellence in research and innovation., thus, building up a national character. Besides the financial grant that it receives from the state government, the University makes every effort to get maximum financial assistance from the various central funding agencies such as UGC, CSIR, ICSSR and DST, etc.

During the Covid period, the University continued its online teaching-learning programmes. The University organised more than 80 online lectures in a period of around three months.

Aspiring to touch the apex of success in all domains of knowledge, the University has shifted to its own magnificent complex. As a part of the first phase of the construction of the entire campus, two up-to-date teaching blocks have been constructed at the cost of about 89.16 crore rupees. As the second part of phase one, the project of around 70.86 crore for the construction of roads, powerhouses, sewerage system, herbal gardens, students' facilitation centres, underground water tank, rain water holding tank and other developmental work rupees has been initiated.

Block-I

Administrative cum Teaching Block

This is the new building of Government College of Education, Bhiwani and the college was scheduled to shift to it but before that it was given to the University by the Government. Now it is the Administrative cum teaching block of the University.

Offices of the Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Dean Academic Affairs and Controller of Examinations are housed in this Block. Several important branches like Accounts branch, Conduct Branch, Result Branch, Academic Branch, and Establishment Branch are also housed in this Block. Besides, the University Library, Department of Hindi and Political Science are also housed in this Block.

Block-II

Teaching Block

It is a full-fledged building of State Institute of Educational Management and Training (SIEMT) but now major portion of it is given to the University by the State Government and the State Institute of Educational Management and Training is operating from some portion of it. Several teaching departments like English, Social Work, Media and Communication Studies, Commerce, Economics, Management and Psychology are housed in it.

Block –III

Administrative Offices

This Block houses the University Engineering Branch, Public Relation Affairs, Purchase & Store Branch and part of Examination Branch of the University.

Administrative Offices

Some of the teaching department like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, ICT, Geography, Zoology, Botany, Microbiology, Bio-technology, Pharamaceutical Science and History were shifted to the new campuses of the university located at Premnagar Bhiwani. The two newly constructed blocks are called Srinivasa Ramanujan Bhawan and Har Gobind Khorana Bhawan.
