1. Introduction

2. Objectives of the Collaboration

The proposed collaboration shall aim to achieve the following objectives:

- Introduce emerging and disruptive technologies into the academic framework, including:

- Establish Centers of Excellence and specialized laboratories in emerging technology domains.
- Enhance employability, entrepreneurship and startup culture among the student community.

Interested industry partners may propose collaboration in one or more of the following areas:

Area of Collaboration	Key Activities
Academic Collaboration	Curriculum design & revision, co-teaching/co-certification modules, industry-oriented electives, project mentoring.
Skill Development	Industry certifications (e.g., AWS, Google, Microsoft, Cisco), boot camps, workshops, h and s-on training programmes.
Infrastructure Support	Setting up specialized labs, providing software tools/platform access, cloud infrastructure support.
Internship & Placement	Summer internships, apprenticeship opportunities, campus placement support, pre-placement training.
Research & Innovation	Sponsored research projects, joint consultancy, startup mentoring and incubation support.
Faculty Development	FDPs, industrial exposure training, sabbatical/industry immersion programmes for faculty.

4. Eligibility Criteria

The interested organizations should preferably satisfy the following criteria:

- Be a registered IT, technology, software company, or recognized industry body under applicable law.
- Possess proven experience in technology, training, software development, or engineering services.
- Have demonstrated expertise in emerging technologies relevant to CSE education.
- Have a track record of successful academic-industry collaborations, training programmes, or MoUs with universities/institutions.
- Be capable of supporting internships, live projects, training, or campus placements for students.

The EOI shall be submitted in both hard copy (to the Registrar's Office) and soft copy (via email) formats as specified in Section 9.

6. Selection Process

All EOIs received shall be evaluated by a competent committee constituted by the University. The evaluation shall be based on the following parameters:

- Technical expertise and domain knowledge in relevant CSE areas.
- Experience, credibility and industry standing of the organization.
- Relevance and feasibility of the proposed model of collaboration.
- Industry outreach and campus placement potential.
- Quality of infrastructure and resource support offered.
- Long-term sustainability and scalability of the proposed collaboration.

Shortlisted organizations may be called for a presentation or interaction with the University committee. The University reserves the right to accept or reject any or all EOIs without assigning any reason thereof.

7. Duration of Collaboration

The collaboration shall initially be for a period of Three (03) years, extendable further based on mutual consent, satisfactory performance review and academic outcomes achieved during the initial term.
